Subject: Village Streets, Sidewalks

With the onset of winter, it is necessary everyone does his/ her part and keeps sidewalks clear of snow and ice. Residents are asked to keep hydrants near their property shoveled out. Below is a section from our Village Law regarding keeping sidewalks passable.

As per Local Law # 3 of 1994 “A Local Law Regulating the Use of Village Streets, Sidewalks and Conduct within the Village of Croghan”

Section: 1b. “No owner, occupant, tenant or any person having the charge or control of any premises, situated in the Village of Croghan, shall suffer or permit any snow, ice or any other substance to collect and remain on any sidewalk fronting on or belonging to said premises, so as to impede, obstruct or render dangerous public travel upon such walks for more than 24 hours after being notified by the Board of Trustees of the said Village to remove the same, and upon default, the Village Board shall cause any such obstruction to be so removed and charged the expenses thereof to the owner, occupant or person in control of said premises.”
