

The Treasurer is responsible for the village's economy, finance and revenue.

The treasurer oversees how the money is spent, either directly dictating expenditure or authorizing it as required. It is their responsibility to ensure that the village has enough money to carry out their stated aims and objectives, and that they do not overspend, or under spend. The treasurer collects village taxes, water rent fees and sewer fees. They also report to the board meetings and report on the financial status of the village to ensure checks and balances. Accurate records and supporting documentation must be kept to a reasonable level of detail that provides a clear audit trail for all transactions.
